"The biggest sleeper story of 2009: The city, on one hand, was doing this great cistern rebate program, but they weren't really talking to those in the Land Use Department who were basically preventing cistern finstallation by requiring use of a licensed plumber]. It's already very expensive to install a cistern, and people are already very worried about their money, so to bring in plumbers at their \$85-an-hour wages as opposed to cistern guys, who are paid more like landscapers, would've been prohibitively expensive. [The license is no longer required, Downey says, and the rebate program starts Jan. 1, 2010.1
